Bob Mahler is one of the best well known young bonsai artists in North America. He started his studies with Chase Rosade in New Hope, PA as a teen. He then moved to Tochigi-Ken in Japan



where he spent the next 4 years under the exclusive direction of world-renowned bonsai master Susumo Sudo to improve his mastery of the art and care of bonsai. He returned to the States in 1993 and soon thereafter became the Curator of Bonsai at the Brooklyn Botanic Garden in New York. When the Brandywine Bonsai Society visited the gardens, Bob gave us a wonderful tour.

Bob left Brooklyn in 2005 to pursue a lifelong dream of working with individual collectors via lectures, classes, private collection maintenance, and tours abroad. Bob is fluent in Japanese. His personal favorites for bonsai are Japanese White Pines, Satsuki

Azaleas, and Japanese Flowering Apricots. At this month's meeting, he will instruct us on the care and styling of pines.
